2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 4 weeks after the application term set by the School, six weeks in case of UGR.

- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. [It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]
- 4. Modification and/or Termination of the agreement

In the event of amendments or unilateral termination of existing inter-institutional agreements a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that also a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. Students selected prior the date of notification must be admitted by the receiving institution.

In case of any change of section B (mobility numbers) the signature of a new Interinstitutional Agreement is required.

The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."]
