



Planning for the next academic year

Dear Partner Universities, dear Colleagues, dear incoming students:

Greetings from Florence! We hope you are all well. In view of the uncertainties related to COVID-19, we send you some information about the courses for the next academic year 2020/21 and about the precautions adopted by University of Florence, based on the current Italian sanitary situation, to minimize contacts between students and professors to avoid a reprise of the contagion of the virus.

The 2020/2021 academic year is officially starting on September 21st 2020. However, individual courses can start on different dates: <https://www.psicologia.unifi.it/vp-367-orario-e-calendario-didattico.html>, therefore students are advised to check for the starting date of the specific courses they have selected.

In Autumn, the University of Florence will adopt a heterogeneous blended teaching model. Lectures will be regularly held in the classroom, according to the timetable. The number of students that will be present in individual classes will depend on the capacity of each classroom and on the rules for physical distancing at the time. The University will guarantee the presence of the maximum number of students allowed by the above constraints and the participation of all of them on a rotational basis. All lectures will be also simultaneously transmitted online, allowing students at home to follow and ask questions, and will be recorded for storage on the online platform.

It goes without saying that these procedures will be subjected to changes, which may be more or less favorable, depending on the evolution of the pandemic.
